Celebrity Series Itzhak Perlman, Violin

Saturday, March 29, 2014 7 p.m., Dodd Auditorium

The reigning virtuoso of the violin, Itzhak Perlman enjoys superstar status rarely afforded a classical musician. Beloved for his charm, humanity, and talent, he is treasured by audiences throughout the world. In December 2003 the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts granted Mr. Perlman a Kennedy Center Honor celebrating his distinguished achievements and contributions to the cultural and educational life of our nation.

He proudly possesses four Emmy Awards and 15 Grammy awards. He performed at the 2006 Academy Awards and at the Juilliard School Centennial gala, broadcast nationally on *Live From Lincoln Center*. One of Mr. Perlman's proudest achievements is his collaboration with film score composer John Williams for Steven Spielberg's Academy Award-winning film *Schindler's List*, in which he performed the violin solos. With the UMW Philharmonic, Mr. Perlman will perform the spectacular Beethoven *Violin Concerto*, considered to be one of the greatest concertos for that instrument ever written.


